



No Zodiac was created in late 2009 by drummer Erik Bartow in Chicago, IL.

The band first gained momentum when they released their debut album "Population Control". Prior to the release of the album they started rigorously touring the U.S., which ultimately landed them their first international tour. After touring and growing their fanbase, No Zodiac released their sophomore album "Eternal Misery" which gained significantly more popularity, and even charted on the "Top 10 Metal Albums" on iTunes for just under two weeks.
